

Coronavirus - Information for patients and accompanying persons

Across Europe, patients are currently being infected with the coronavirus. We have compiled some basic instructions for you below.

Patients

- You receive one face mask for the whole stay (Please keep and reuse)
- Reduce walking around the clinic to a minimum
- Always wear your face mask outside the room and if you are in contact with hospital staff inside your room

Accompanying persons

From May 9, 2020, every patient can be visited by one person. This person is also allowed to accompany a patient giving birth.

- Re-entry on the same day is not possible
- Visiting hours: 2:00 p.m. 5:00 p.m.
- The visitor receives a face mask. (Please mark with name, keep it safe, air it out overnight and reuse it)
- Visitors will not be allowed to enter the clinic without their face mask
- If , within the last 14 days, you had contact with a Covid-19 positive person, any signs of respiratory disease or a fever, please stay at home
- Always wear your face mask
- Wait outside on discharge day and do not enter the hospital building
- Bring everything needed on discharge day (e.g. baby seat) to the clinic the day before

Hygiene instructions

- Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly (30 seconds)
- Practise good cough and sneeze etiquette
- Keep your distance (at least 1 meter) to other people
