

Coronavirus - Information for patients and accompanying persons

Due to the current significant increase in incidence numbers, we have to restrict our visitor rights again.

We have compiled the most important information and instructions for action for you here.

Patients

- You receive one face mask (worn over mouth and nose) for the whole stay (Please keep and reuse)
- Reduce walking around the clinic to a minimum
- <u>Always</u> wear your face mask if you are mobile and if you are in contact with hospital staff inside your room

Accompanying persons

- Each obstetrics patient can be accompanied to the birth by one consistent person (e.g. the partner) and then visited. In all other areas no visit can be received at the moment.
- Re-entry on the same day is not possible
- Visiting hours: 10:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- The visitor receives a face mask. (Please mark with name, keep it safe, air it out overnight and reuse it)
- Visitors will not be allowed to enter the clinic without their face mask
- If , within the last 14 days, you had contact with a Covid-19 positive person, any signs of respiratory disease or a fever, please stay at home
- Always wear your face mask

Hygiene instructions

- Wash your hands frequently and thoroughly (30 seconds)
- Practise good cough and sneeze etiquette
- Keep your distance (at least 1 meter) to other people
